☐ Definition of Minimum Residence Requirement

- o Minimum Residence Requirement
 - : Refers to the minimum term required to complete a course of study
 - Master's & Doctoral Program : 4 semesters
 - Integrated Program: 8 semesters
- O Students who have acquired a number of credits greater than that required to be awarded a degree, the time required for graduation from the school may be reduced by 1 semester for Master's and Doctoral program and by up to $1 \sim 2$ semester for Integrated courses. \Rightarrow Early Course Completion



- Even if there is an application to shorten their Minimum Residence Requirement, the application may be rejected depending on application requirements.
 - If the requirements have not been satisfied, the students must enroll and take classes for the remaining semesters.
- O Students who wish to graduate early in the semester have to apply.
- Some campuses has own criteria of degree acquirement. So students should check that all the required courses is already completed.


Common requirement
